Even when possessing nothing, sharing oneself with others. This shows that generosity comes not from excess but from an abundance mindset.

ko aaisaa bhagat sadhaae ||128||

Only such an individual can be called a devoted seeker. This states that a devotee's state is earned through virtues rather than rituals. (128)

He argues that true realization is marked not by ostentatious displays of power or intellect, but by their meaningful application. A genuine seeker transcends the ego's craving for validation, embracing humility over dominance and choosing generosity instead of mere accumulation.
